<p>3 Personal data group</p>	<p>Finnish Red Cross / Event participants</p>
<p>4 The purpose of processing personal data</p>	<p>The purpose of processing personal data is to collect the information necessary for the organisation of and participation in an event, to provide information about matters related to the event and to collect feedback.</p> <p>The basis for processing personal data is the legitimate interest of the controller to ensure the smooth running and security of events.</p> <p>Events can be organised by the headquarters, a district or a branch of the Finnish Red Cross, Red Cross First Aid, Youth Shelters, the Kontti chain or the Blood Service.</p> <p>The personal data may be processed, as necessary, by all parties involved in the organisation of events, including employees, volunteers and external organisers</p> <p>The personal data pertaining to events are retained for 6 months after the event has ended, after which they are destroyed.</p>
<p>5 Data content of the register</p>	<p>The following data may be processed in the register:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ name, contact and billing information ○ gender ○ date of birth ○ language ○ personal identity code or other identifier ○ food and other health restrictions ○ contact details of guardians ○ FRC membership, district or branch information ○ other event-specific information, such as T-shirt size, level of swimming ability.

<p>6 Regular data sources</p>	<p>The personal data are received from event participants or their guardians.</p>
<p>7 Regular disclosures of data</p>	<p>The personal data are not disclosed to parties outside the organisation, unless the practical organisation of the event requires it.</p> <p>The personal data in the register may be disclosed to the authorities in cases required by law.</p>
<p>8 Transfer of data outside the EU or EEA</p>	<p>The personal data may be processed in systems whose use requires the data to be transferred to the United States. The transfer is based on an adequate level of data protection guaranteed by Data Privacy Framework certification approved by the European Commission.</p>
<p>9 Data protection principles of the register</p>	<p>Personal data processed in physical form: Material that is processed in its physical form is stored and handled in monitored facilities.</p> <p>Digital material: The data are processed in protected systems that may only be accessed by persons whose work role gives them the right to process the personal data in question.</p>
<p>10 Rights of data subjects</p>	<p>Data subjects have the right to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • request a copy of their personal data • request that their personal data be amended or deleted, unless applicable data security regulations require that the data be retained • request restrictions on the processing of their personal data or oppose this processing • request the right to transfer their data from one system to another, in accordance with applicable data security legislation • refuse, in full or in part, any contact made for the purpose of direct marketing and research • submit a complaint to the supervisory authority. <p>Requests for the exercise of data subjects' rights should be addressed in the first instance to tietosuoja@redcross.fi.</p>
